

## TAX CUTS

684,000 Nebraskans benefitted from the Making Work Pay tax cut, putting a total of \$346 million into Nebraskans' pockets in 2009 and \$327 million in 2010<sup>1,2</sup>. The Making Work Pay tax cut put more than **\$6,432,000** back into the economy of Adams County in 2009 and **\$6,076,000** in 2010<sup>3</sup>.

## EDUCATION

Adams County's school districts were saved from making further cuts to their budgets through the use of over **\$6,674,000** in Recovery Act funds, including over<sup>4</sup>:

Silver Lake Public Schools*	\$85,000
Educational Service Unit #9*	\$33,000

## COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT

Over **\$842,000** in community improvement projects were also funded through the Recovery Act, including over<sup>5</sup>:



### Public Safety

- \$53,000 - City of Hastings - Public Safety Equipment
- \$109,000 - City of Hastings - Energy Efficient Lighting

## NEBRASKA DEPARTMENT OF THE MILITARY

The Nebraska Department of the Military was given over **\$1,036,000** for Greenlief Training Site Buildings modifications funded through the Recovery Act. Funds were disbursed among buildings as follows<sup>7</sup>:

- Greenlief Training Site - Building 600 - Fire Protection System
- Greenlief Training Site - Building 610 - Fire Protection System
- Greenlief Training Site - Building 620 - Fire Protection System
- Greenlief Training Site - Washrack Modifications

## LOAN ASSISTANCE


**\$461,000** in Rural Development Single Family Housing Guaranteed loans were awarded to individuals in Adams County<sup>8</sup>.

## FIRST TIME HOMEBUYER CREDIT

More than 22,000 Nebraskans benefited from the First Time Homebuyer tax credit, returning more than **\$155.8 million** to the Nebraska economy from 2008 to 2010<sup>9</sup>.




## Bridge Rehabilitation
