

TAX CUTS

684,000 Nebraskans benefitted from the Making Work Pay tax cut, putting a total of \$346 million into Nebraskans' pockets in 2009 and \$327 million in 2010^{1,2}. The Making Work Pay tax cut put more than **\$65,000** back into the economy of Arthur County in 2009 and **\$61,000** in 2010³.

Educational Service Unit #16*	\$19,000




FIRST TIME HOMEBUYER CREDIT
