

+\$9,875,000

TAX CUTS

684,000 Nebraskans benefitted from the Making Work Pay tax cut, putting a total of \$346 million into Nebraskans' pockets in 2009 and \$327 million in 2010^{1,2}. The Making Work Pay tax cut put over **\$1,762,000** back into the economy of Cuming County in 2009 and **\$1,665,000** in 2010³.

EDUCATION

Cuming County's school districts were saved from making further cuts to their budgets through the use of over **\$793,000** in Recovery Act funds, including over⁴:



Bancroft-Rosalie Community Schools	\$285,000
West Point Public Schools	\$329,000
Wisner-Pilger Public Schools	\$154,000
Educational Service Unit #2*	\$25,000

COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT

Over **\$5,053,000** in community improvement projects have been funded through the Recovery Act, including over⁵:

Energy Efficiency & Green Industry

- \$39,000 - Stalp Gravel Company low emission engines
- \$1,124,000 – Cuming County Public Power District – modernization of electric system⁶

Housing

- \$27,000 - Beemer Housing Authority⁷

Human Services

- \$3,863,000 - Goldenrod Hills Community Action, Inc. – financial assistance to low-income families



LOAN ASSISTANCE


Over **\$602,000** in loans were awarded to individuals in Cuming County, including⁸:

- \$131,000 - Farm Services Agency Farm Operating Direct Loans
- \$471,000 - Rural Development Single Family Housing Guaranteed Loans

FIRST TIME HOMEBUYER CREDIT

More than 22,000 Nebraskans benefited from the First Time Homebuyer tax credit, returning more than **\$155.8 million** to the Nebraska economy from 2008 to 2010⁹.
