

TAX CUTS

684,000 Nebraskans benefitted from the Making Work Pay tax cut, putting a total of \$346 million into Nebraskans' pockets in 2009 and \$327 million in 2010^{1,2}. The Making Work Pay tax cut put over **\$354,000** back into the economy of Deuel County in 2009 and **\$335,000** in 2010³.

EDUCATION



Deuel County's school districts were saved from making further cuts to their budgets through the use of over **\$339,000** in Recovery Act funds. This included funds for⁴:

Creek Valley Schools	\$267,000
South Platte Public Schools	\$53,000
Educational Service Unit #16*	\$19,000

LOAN ASSISTANCE

Over **\$85,000** in Rural Development Single Family Housing Guaranteed Loans were awarded to individuals in Deuel County⁵.



COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT

Over **\$169,000** in community improvement projects were also funded through the Recovery Act, making vital investments in Deuel County's communities. This includes over⁶:




Community Facilities

- \$63,000 - Chappell Senior Center - transit vehicles and transit facility



Housing

- \$53,000 - Goldsboro Housing Authority - handicapped parking spaces & updating housing units
- \$53,000-Chappell Housing Authority - handicapped parking spaces & updating housing units⁷



FIRST TIME HOMEBUYER CREDIT

More than 22,000 Nebraskans benefited from the First Time Homebuyer tax credit, returning more than **\$155.8 million** to the Nebraska economy from 2008 to 2010⁸.

Many road projects were made possible through the Recovery Act. Deuel County was given over **\$11,017,000** for road projects, including?:



★ Resurfacing


- \$6,943,000 - Interstate 80 - Chappell to Oshkosh

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
