

TAX CUTS

684,000 Nebraskans benefitted from the Making Work Pay tax cut, putting a total of \$346 million into Nebraskans' pockets in 2009 and \$327 million in 2010^{1,2}. The Making Work Pay tax cut put over **\$6,879,000** back into the economy of Dodge County in 2009 and **\$6,498,000** in 2010³.

EDUCATION

Dodge County's school districts were saved from making further cuts to their budgets through the use of over **\$7,344,000** in Recovery Act funds, including more than⁴:

Dodge Public Schools	\$64,000
Fremont Public Schools	\$6,548,000
Logan View Public Schools	\$415,000
North Bend Central Public Schools	\$146,000
Scribner-Snyder Community Schools	\$146,000
Educational Service Unit #2*	\$25,000



FIRST TIME HOMEBUYER CREDIT

More than 22,000 Nebraskans benefitted from the First Time Homebuyer tax credit, returning more than **\$155.8 million** to the Nebraska economy from 2008 to 2010⁵.

COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT

Over **\$2,181,000** in community improvement projects were also funded through the Recovery Act, including over⁶:

☆ Housing

- \$37,000 - Hooper Housing Authority - new carpet and vinyl flooring



☆ Human Services

- \$59,000 - Midland Lutheran College - early Head Start Assistance
- \$14,000 - Crisis Center for Domestic Abuse & Sexual Assault - crisis intervention

☆ Energy Efficiency & Green Industry

- \$1,174,000 - Fremont Housing Authority - Elevator replacement and energy retrofits
- \$39,000 - Fremont Contract Carriers - Nebraska's Clean Diesel Program
- \$106,000 - City of Fremont - HVAC systems

☆ Public Safety

- \$38,000 - City of Fremont - police funding
- \$104,000 - City of Fremont - multi-jurisdictional task forces

☆ Other Community Improvement

- \$610,000 - City of Fremont - Community Development⁷



LOAN ASSISTANCE

Over **\$1,388,000** in loans were awarded to individuals in Dodge County, including⁸:

- \$483,000 - Farm Service Agency Farm Operating Direct Loans
- \$735,000 - Rural Development Single Family Housing Guaranteed Loans
- \$170,000 - Rural Development Water & Waste Disposal Loans

ROADS


Many road projects were made possible through the Recovery Act. Over **\$759,000** in road projects were funded in Dodge County, including over⁹:

☆ Resurfacing

- \$132,000 - City of Fremont - main street
- \$627,000 - City of Scribner - bridge over Cuming Creek
