

TAX CUTS

684,000 Nebraskans benefitted from the Making Work Pay tax cut, putting a total of \$346 million into Nebraskans' pockets in 2009 and \$327 million in 2010^{1,2}. The Making Work Pay tax cut put more than **\$377,000** back into the economy of Dundy County in 2009 and **\$356,000** in 2010³.

Division of Funding in Dundy County



EDUCATION

Dundy County's School District was saved from making further cuts to its budget through the use of over **\$372,000** in Recovery Act funds, including⁴:

Dundy County Stratton Public Schools*	\$359,000
Educational Service Unit #15*	\$13,000

COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT

Community improvement projects were also funded through the Recovery Act, making investments in Dundy County.



Housing

- \$59,000 - Benkelman Housing Authority - improve housing units⁵



LOAN ASSISTANCE

Over **\$201,000** in loans were awarded to individuals in Dundy County, including over⁶:

- \$130,000 - Farm Service Agency Farm Operating Direct Loans
- \$71,000 - Rural Development Single Family Housing Guaranteed Loans


FIRST TIME HOMEBUYER CREDIT

More than 22,000 Nebraskans benefited from the First Time Homebuyer tax credit, returning more than **\$155.8 million** to the Nebraska economy from 2008 to 2010⁷.
