TAX CUTS


684,000 Nebraskans are benefitting from the Making Work Pay tax cut, putting a total of \$346 million into Nebraskans' pockets in 2009 and \$327 million in 2010^{1,2}. The Making Work Pay tax cut put over **\$1,150,000** back into the economy of Fillmore County in 2009 and **\$1,087,000** in 2010³.

EDUCATION

Fillmore County public schools received **\$679,000** in Recovery Act funds, preventing the schools from making additional cuts to their budgets, including over⁴:

Exeter-Milligan Public Schools	\$85,000
Fillmore Central Public Schools	\$217,000
Geneva North School	\$1,000
Shickley Public Schools	\$38,000
Educational Service Unit #6*	\$338,000

COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT



Over **\$316,000** in community improvement projects were also funded through the Recovery Act, including over⁵:

☆ Housing

- \$26,000 - Fairmont Housing Authority

☆ Human Services

- \$1,000 - Department of Health & Human Services - nutritional service equipment in Geneva

☆ Infrastructure

- \$289,000 - Village of Ohioa - sewer improvements⁶

LOAN ASSISTANCE

FIRST TIME HOMEBUYER CREDIT

More than 22,000 Nebraskans benefited from the First Time Homebuyer tax credit, returning more than **\$155.8 million** to the Nebraska economy from 2008 to 2010⁷.


Over **\$13,406,000** in loans were awarded to individuals in Fillmore County, including⁸:

- \$90,000 - Farm Service Agency Farm Operating Direct Loans
- \$427,000 - Rural Development Single Family Housing Direct Loans & Guaranteed Loans
- \$289,000 - Rural Development Water & Waste Disposal Loans
- \$12,600,000 - Rural Development Community Facility Loans

ROADS

Fillmore County received over **\$396,000** for construction of a new bridge over a tributary of Turkey Creek on a county road 2.6 miles east of Geneva⁹.
