

TAX CUTS

684,000 Nebraskans benefitted from the Making Work Pay tax cut, putting a total of \$346 million into Nebraskans' pockets in 2009 and \$327 million in 2010^{1,2}. The Making Work Pay tax cut put over **\$1,791,000** back into the economy of Hamilton County in 2009 and **\$1,692,000** in 2010³.

EDUCATION

Hamilton County's school districts received over **\$1,085,000** from the Recovery Act, preventing the school districts from making additional cuts to their budgets, including over⁴:

Aurora Public Schools	\$869,000
Giltner Public Schools	\$128,000
Hampton Public Schools	\$55,000
Educational Service Unit #9*	\$33,000



COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT

Over **\$7,060,000** in community improvement projects have been funded through the Recovery Act, including funding for⁵:

- \$59,000 – Aurora Housing Authority – remodeling
- \$301,000 – Village of Phillips – drinking water infrastructure
- \$6,700,000 – Memorial Community Health, Inc. – remodeling⁶

LOAN ASSISTANCE

Over **\$7,264,000** in loans were awarded to individuals in Hamilton County, including⁷:


- \$235,000 - Farm Service Agency Farm Operating Direct Loans
- \$329,000 - Rural Development Single Family Housing Guaranteed Loans
- \$6,700,000 - Rural Development Community Facility Loans



FIRST TIME HOMEBUYER CREDIT

More than 22,000 Nebraskans benefited from the First Time Homebuyer tax credit, returning more than **\$155.8 million** to the Nebraska economy from 2008 to 2010⁸.
