

## TAX CUTS

684,000 Nebraskans benefitted from the Making Work Pay tax cut, putting a total of \$346 million into Nebraskans' pockets in 2009 and \$327 million in 2010<sup>1,2</sup>. The Making Work Pay tax cut put over **\$690,000** back into the economy of Kimball County in 2009 and **\$652,000** in 2010<sup>3</sup>.

## EDUCATION

Kimball Public Schools received over **\$384,000** from the Recovery Act, preventing the district from making additional cuts to its budget<sup>4</sup>.

## COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT

Community improvement projects have been funded through the Recovery Act in Kimball County, including over **\$44,000** to improve transit services<sup>5</sup>.



## LOAN ASSISTANCE

Over **\$305,000** in Rural Development Single Family Housing Direct Loans & Guaranteed Loans were awarded to individuals in Kimball County<sup>6</sup>.



## FIRST TIME HOMEBUYER CREDIT


More than 22,000 Nebraskans benefitted from the First Time Homebuyer tax credit, returning more than **\$155.8 million** to the Nebraska economy from 2008 to 2010<sup>7</sup>.



## ROADS

The Nebraska Department of Roads was awarded over **\$4,633,000** to resurface and widen Nebraska Highway 78.
