

TAX CUTS

684,000 Nebraskans benefitted from the Making Work Pay tax cut, putting a total of \$346 million into Nebraskans' pockets in 2009 and \$327 million in 2010^{1,2}. The Making Work Pay tax cut put more than **\$141,000** back into the economy of Logan County in 2009 and **\$133,000** in 2010³.

EDUCATION

Logan County's school was saved from making further cuts to its budget through the use of over **\$121,000** in Recovery funds, including over⁴:

Stapleton Public Schools	\$102,000

Over **\$115,000** in Farm Service Agency Farm Operating Direct Loans were awarded to individuals in Logan County⁵.



FIRST TIME HOMEBUYER CREDIT

More than 22,000 Nebraskans benefitted from the First Time Homebuyer tax credit, returning more than **\$155.8 million** to the Nebraska economy from 2008 to 2010⁶.


