

## TAX CUTS

684,000 Nebraskans benefitted from the Making Work Pay tax cut, putting a total of \$346 million into Nebraskans' pockets in 2009 and \$327 million in 2010<sup>1,2</sup>. The Making Work Pay tax cut put more than **\$127,000** back into the economy of Loup County in 2009 and **\$120,000** in 2010<sup>3</sup>.

## EDUCATION

Loup County's school received over **\$396,000** from the Recovery Act, preventing the school district from making additional cuts to its budgets<sup>4</sup>.

## FIRST TIME HOMEBUYER CREDIT


More than 22,000 Nebraskans benefitted from the First Time Homebuyer tax credit, returning more than **\$155.8 million** to the Nebraska economy from 2008 to 2010<sup>5</sup>.
