

## TAX CUTS

684,000 Nebraskans benefitted from the Making Work Pay tax cut, putting a total of \$346 million into Nebraskans' pockets in 2009 and \$327 million in 2010<sup>1,2</sup>. For Madison County, that meant a savings of over **\$6,660,000** in taxes in 2009 and **\$6,291,000** in 2010<sup>3</sup>.

## EDUCATION


Madison County's school districts were saved from making further cuts to their budgets through the use of over **\$5,523,000** in Recovery Act funds, including over<sup>4</sup>:



Battle Creek Public Schools	\$260,000
Elkhorn Valley Schools	\$106,000
Madison Public Schools	\$676,000
Newman Grove Public Schools	\$78,000
Norfolk Public Schools	\$4,387,000
Educational Service Unit #8*	\$16,000

## FIRST TIME HOMEBUYER CREDIT

More than 22,000 Nebraskans benefited from the First Time Homebuyer tax credit, returning more than **\$155.8 million** to the Nebraska economy from 2008 to 2010<sup>5</sup>.



## LOAN ASSISTANCE

Over **\$5,402,000** in loans were awarded to individuals in Madison County, including<sup>6</sup>:

- \$221,000 - Farm Service Agency Farm Operating Direct Loans
- \$5,181,000 - Rural Development Single Family Housing Guaranteed Loans


## COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT

---

Over **\$717,000** in community improvement projects were also funded through the Recovery Act in Madison County, including<sup>7</sup>:

### ★ Housing

- \$28,000 - Tilden Housing Authority
- \$27,000 - Newman Grove Housing Authority



### ★ Human Services

- \$283,000 - Norfolk Community Health Care Clinic
- \$18,000 - Community Concern of Norfolk , Inc.
- \$60,000 - Northeast Nebraska Area Agency on Aging - meals to senior citizen facilities<sup>8</sup>
- \$29,000 - Northeast Nebraska Area Agency on Aging - meals for homebound adults<sup>9</sup>
- \$115,000 – Norfolk Community Health Care Clinic – staff <sup>10</sup>

### ★ Energy Efficiency & Green Industry

- \$101,000 - City of Norfolk - Energy Efficiency Improvements at Norfolk Public Library

### ★ Public Safety

- \$26,000 - City of Norfolk - purchase of tasers
- \$30,000 - City of Norfolk - Justice Assistance Grant<sup>11</sup>

## PONCA TRIBE OF NEBRASKA

---

The Ponca Tribe of Nebraska was given over **\$629,000** for the purchasing and modernization of rental housing units<sup>12</sup>.




# ROADS

Many road projects were made possible through the Recovery Act. Madison County was given over **\$3,643,000** for road projects. These funds include over<sup>13</sup>:




## Resurfacing
