

TAX CUTS

684,000 Nebraskans are benefitting from the Making Work Pay tax cut, putting a total of \$346 million into Nebraskans' pockets in 2009 and \$327 million in 2010^{1,2}. For Nance County, that meant a savings of over **\$667,000** in taxes in 2009 and **\$630,000** in 2010³.

EDUCATION

Nance County's school districts were saved from making further cuts to their budgets through the use of over **\$737,000** in Recovery Act funds. These funds include over⁴:

Fullerton Public Schools	\$375,000
Twin River Public Schools	\$276,000
Educational Service Unit #7*	\$86,000

COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT

Over **\$60,000** in community improvement projects were also funded through the Recovery Act, including⁵:



Housing

- \$31,000 - Genoa Housing Authority - upgrade kitchen facilities in Sunrise Villa



Human Services

- \$29,000 - Fullerton Area Senior Center, Inc. - purchase new transit vehicles

Over **\$22,204,000** in loans were awarded to individuals in Nance County, including⁶:


- \$35,000 - Farm Service Agency Farm Operating Direct Loans

FIRST TIME HOMEBUYER CREDIT

More than 22,000 Nebraskans benefited from the First Time Homebuyer tax credit, returning more than **\$155.8 million** to the Nebraska economy from 2008 to 2010⁷.
