

TAX CUTS

684,000 Nebraskans benefitted from the Making Work Pay tax cut, putting a total of \$346 million into Nebraskans' pockets in 2009 and \$327 million in 2010^{1,2}. For Nuckolls County, that meant a savings of over **\$836,000** in taxes in 2009 and **\$790,000** in 2010³.

EDUCATION


Nuckolls County's school districts were saved from making further cuts to their budgets through the use of over **\$1,090,000** in Recovery Act funds, including over⁴:

South Central Nebraska Unified System 5*	\$454,000
Superior Public Schools	\$603,000
Educational Service Unit #9*	\$33,000

LOAN ASSISTANCE

Over **\$1,631,000** in loans were awarded to individuals in Nuckolls County, including⁵:

- \$263,000 in Rural Development Single Family Housing Guaranteed Loans
- \$1,368,000 in Rural Development Water & Waste Disposal Loans



FIRST TIME HOMEBUYER CREDIT


More than 22,000 Nebraskans benefited from the First Time Homebuyer tax credit, returning more than **\$155.8 million** to the Nebraska economy from 2008 to 2010⁶.



ROADS

Many road projects were made possible through the Recovery Act. Nuckolls County was given over **\$254,000** for the County Road Bridge replacement at Oak South⁷.
