

TAX CUTS

684,000 Nebraskans are benefitting from the Making Work Pay tax cut, putting a total of \$346 million into Nebraskans' pockets in 2009 and \$327 million in 2010^{1,2}. The Making Work Pay tax cut put more than **\$534,000** back into the economy of Perkins County in 2009 and **\$504,000** in 2010³.

EDUCATION

Perkins County's schools received over **\$213,000** in Recovery Act funds, preventing the district from making additional cuts to its budget⁴.

- \$88,000 - Rural Housing Insurance Guaranteed Loans




FIRST TIME HOMEBUYER CREDIT
