

TAX CUTS

684,000 Nebraskans are benefitting from the Making Work Pay tax cut, putting a total of \$346 million into Nebraskans' pockets in 2009 and \$327 million in 2010^{1,2}. For Richardson County, that meant a savings of over **\$1,568,000** in taxes in 2009 and **\$1,481,000** in 2010³.

EDUCATION

Richardson County's school districts were saved from making further cuts to their budgets through the use of over **\$1,469,000** in Recovery Act funds, including⁴:

Falls City Public Schools	\$1,040,000
Humboldt-Table Rock-Steinauer Public Schools	\$399,000
Educational Service Unit #4*	\$30,000

COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT

Over **\$1,706,000** in community improvement projects were also funded through the Recovery Act. This includes over⁵:

★ Housing

- \$41,000 - Humboldt Housing Authority - widow replacement in housing units
- \$138,000 - Falls City Housing Authority - HVAC installation in housing units



★ Human Services

- \$1,527,000 - Southeast NE Community Action Council - employment, housing, emergency services, Head Start and weatherization programs

LOAN ASSISTANCE


Over **\$5,359,000** in loans were awarded to individuals in Richardson County, including⁶:

- \$86,000 - Farm Service Agency Farm Operating Direct Loans
- \$83,000 - Rural Development Single Family Housing Guaranteed Loans
- \$1,800,000 - Rural Development Business & Industry Guaranteed Loans
- \$3,390,000 - Distance Learning Telemedicine and Broadband Direct Loans⁷

FIRST TIME HOMEBUYER CREDIT

More than 22,000 Nebraskans benefited from the First Time Homebuyer tax credit, returning more than **\$155.8 million** to the Nebraska economy from 2008 to 2010⁸.
