

## TAX CUTS

684,000 Nebraskans benefited from the Making Work Pay tax cut, putting a total of \$346 million into Nebraskans' pockets in 2009 and \$327 million in 2010<sup>1,2</sup>. The Making Work Pay tax cut put more than **\$291,000** back into the economy of Rock County in 2009 and **\$275,000** in 2010<sup>3</sup>.

## EDUCATION

Rock County's school district was saved from making further cuts to its budgets through the use of over **\$87,000** in Recovery Act funds, including over<sup>4</sup>:

Rock County Public Schools	\$86,000
Educational Service Unit #17*	\$1,000



## COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT

Over **\$62,000** in community improvement projects have been funded through the Recovery Act in Rock County, making investments in vital community needs<sup>5</sup>.



### Housing

- \$33,000 - Bassett Housing Authority - improvements to Meadow View Apartments



### Human Services

- \$29,000 - Rock County Community Hospital - purchase of medical equipment<sup>6</sup>

## FIRST TIME HOMEBUYER CREDIT

More than 22,000 Nebraskans benefited from the First Time Homebuyer tax credit, returning more than **\$155.8 million** to the Nebraska economy from 2008 to 2010<sup>7</sup>.


## LOAN ASSISTANCE
