

## Division of Funding in Sioux County

### TAX CUTS

684,000 Nebraskans benefitted from the Making Work Pay tax cut, putting a total of \$346 million into Nebraskans' pockets in 2009 and \$327 million in 2010<sup>1,2</sup>. For Sioux County, that meant a savings of over **\$247,000** in taxes in 2009 and **\$233,000** in 2010<sup>3</sup>.

### EDUCATION

Sioux County received over **\$73,000** for school stabilization. This includes over<sup>4</sup>:

Sioux County Public Schools	\$36,000
Educational Service Unit #13*	\$37,000

### LOAN ASSISTANCE

- Over **\$472,000** in loans were awarded to individuals in Sioux County, including<sup>5</sup>:
- \$415,000 - Farm Service Agency Farm Operating Direct Loans
  - \$57,000 - Rural Development Single Family Housing Guaranteed Loans




### FIRST TIME HOMEBUYER CREDIT

More than 22,000 Nebraskans benefitted from the First Time Homebuyer tax credit, returning more than **\$155.8 million** to the Nebraska economy from 2008 to 2010<sup>6</sup>.
