

TAX CUTS

684,000 Nebraskans are benefitting from the Making Work Pay tax cut, putting a total of \$346 million into Nebraskans' pockets in 2009 and \$327 million in 2010^{1,2}. The Making Work Pay tax cut put more than **\$2,670,000** back into the economy of York County in 2009 and **\$2,523,000** in 2010³.

EDUCATION

York County schools received over **\$1,922,000** from the Recovery Act, preventing the schools from making additional cuts to their budgets⁴:

Cross County Community Schools	\$119,000
Heartland Community Schools	\$147,000
McCool Junction Public Schools	\$215,000
York Public Schools	\$1,222,000
Educational Service Unit #6*	\$338,000

COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENTS

Over **\$3,385,000** in community improvement projects have been funded through the Recovery Act in York County, including funding for⁵:

★ Housing

- \$28,000 - Henderson Housing Authority - replace exhaust fans
- \$111,000 - Westgate Manor - back-up generator
- \$19,000 - Gresham Housing Authority - carpeting in housing units⁶
- \$111,000 - Leisure Home, Inc. - backup generator⁷

★ Infrastructure

- \$2,865,000 - City of York - drinking water infrastructure
- \$249,000 - Village of Bradshaw - Clean drinking water revolving fund⁸

★ Human Service

- \$2,000 - Epworth Village - nutrition service equipment

LOAN ASSISTANCE

Over **\$2,246,000** in loans were awarded to individuals in York County, including⁹:

- \$26,000 - Farm Service Agency Farm Operating Direct Loans
- \$2,220,000 - Rural Housing Development Single Family Guaranteed Loans



FIRST TIME HOMEBUYER CREDIT

More than 22,000 Nebraskans benefited from the First Time Homebuyer tax credit, returning more than **\$155.8 million** to the Nebraska economy from 2008 to 2010¹⁰.

ROADS


The Recovery Act provided over **\$4,907,000** for road projects in York County¹¹:
